






1. THE HARDEST JOB IN THE CHURCH IS THE CHILDREN'S MINISTER




1 Peter 4: 8 Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. 9 Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.



2. THE GOSPEL IS MUCH BIGGER THAN YOU MIGHT THINK.





3. IT'S ALL ABOUT DISCIPLESHIP




Matthew 28: 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations...






Proverbs 26: 4 Do not answer a fool according to his folly or you yourself will be just like him.




8. CHURCHES UNWILLING




9. IF WE DON'T PRAY TOGETHER, WE WILL NOT STAY TOGETHER.


10. THE HOLY SPIRIT WORKS ON THE EDGES
