

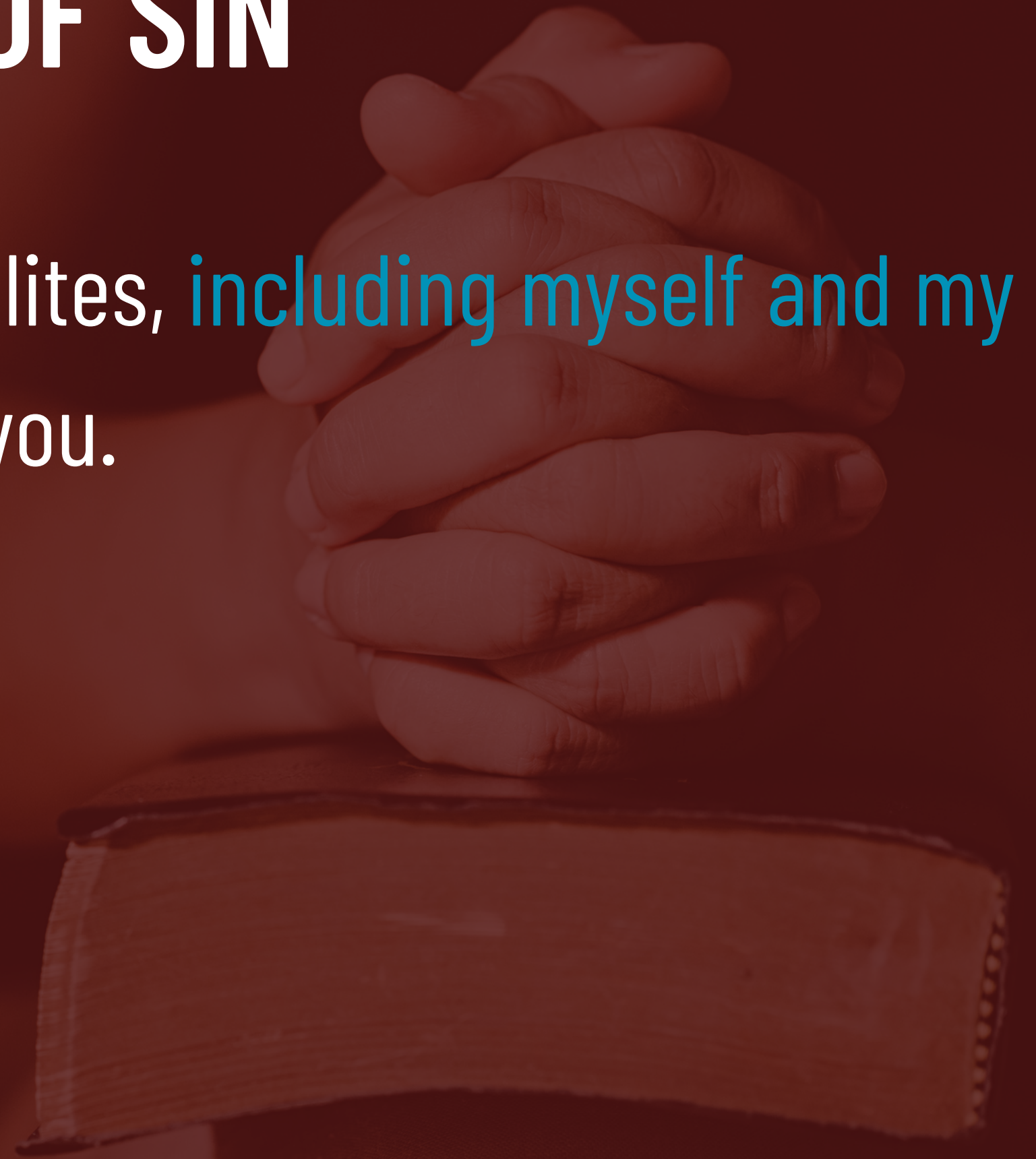

Nehemiah 1: 6 I confess the sins we Israelites, including myself and my father's family, have committed against you.

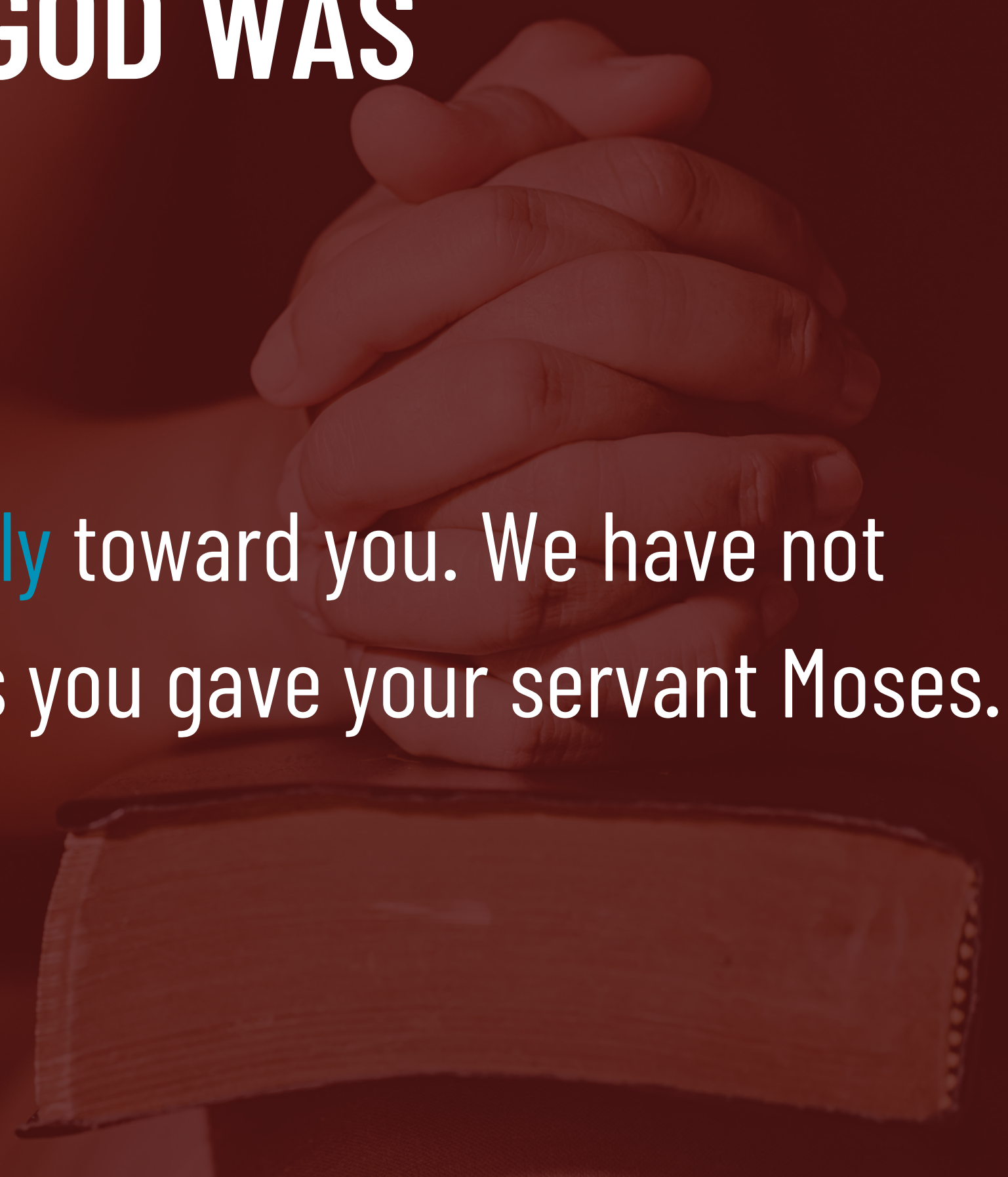


NEHEMIAH WEPT BECAUSE OF SIN

Nehemiah 1:7 We have **acted very wickedly** toward you. We have not obeyed the commands, decrees and laws you gave your servant Moses.




WHY JESUS WEPT


