(1) Context of Saul's rejection of
God's commands.

1 Samuel 13: 13 “You have done a foolish thing,” Samuel said. “You have not kept the command the Lord your God gave you; if you had, he would have established your kingdom over Israel for all time. 14 But now your kingdom will not endure; the Lord has sought out a man after his own heart and appointed him ruler of his people, **because you have not kept the Lord’s command.**”

1 Samuel 13:14

(2) David is only a child.

1 Samuel 16: 7 But the Lord said to Samuel, “Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, **but the Lord looks at the heart.**”

Having a heart after God's own
has nothing to do with your
accomplishments.

Ruth 1: 16 But Ruth replied, “Don’t urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and **your God my God**. **17** Where you die I will die, and there I will be buried. May the Lord deal with me, be it ever so severely, if even death separates you and me.”

Ruth had a heart after God's
own because she **lived** in
covenant **faithfulness** to the
one true God.

Psalms 16: 2 I say to the Lord, “You are my Lord;
apart from you I have no good thing.”

4 Those who run after other gods will suffer more
and more.

I will not pour out libations of blood to such gods
or take up their names on my lips.

8 I have **set the Lord continually before me**;
Because He is at my right hand, I will not be
shaken.

The heart after God's own
acknowledges Yahweh **alone** is
God.

Idolatry doesn't require us to
abandon God.

It only asks for a small
percentage of trust in other
things.

Faithlessness, not sinfulness,
opens the door to idolatry.

Psalm 119: 2 Blessed are those who keep his statutes

and **seek him with all their heart.**

**(3) In his dealings with his
enemies.**

1 Samuel 17: 34 But David said to Saul, “Your servant has been keeping his father’s sheep. When a lion or a bear came and carried off a sheep from the flock, **35** I went after it, struck it and rescued the sheep from its mouth. When it turned on me, I seized it by its hair, struck it and killed it. **37 The Lord who rescued me** from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will rescue me from the hand of this Philistine.”
