SERMON NOTES - TRIED AND TESTED  
Discovering God’s Presence Through Trial

What flows \_\_\_\_\_ must flow \_\_\_\_\_.

A “test” is a challenging circumstance placed in our \_\_\_\_\_ by God for a specific purpose.

A “test” is not a \_\_\_\_\_/ \_\_\_\_\_ concept for the Hebrews.

God tested them to “\_\_\_\_\_” what was in their hearts.

“Know” is “ya’da” in Hebrew. It’s not a cerebral knowledge but a knowledge of \_\_\_\_\_.

Two Reasons God Tests Us
